

## **U.S. Army STOC II**

The U.S. Army Program Executive Office for Simulation, Training and Instrumentation (PEO STRI) second STRI Omnibus Contract, known as STOC II, is an efficient contracting vehicle for quickly acquiring simulation and training products and services for U.S. and coalition service members. The overall purpose of STOC II is to have highly-qualified contractors on hand to rapidly satisfy the needs of the nation's Warfighters.

STOC II provides multiple-award, IDIQ contracts for the full spectrum of simulation, modeling, training, test, and instrumentation products and services, beginning with concept development and continuing throughout lifecycle support. PEO STRI established both the Full and Open Lot and the Partial Small Business Set Aside Lot to enhance its ability to achieve its small business goals.
